Once the student is proficient with the questions organized into chapters then they are ready for random questions. 2) This study guide has thousands of practice problems. I have placed over 3100 videos on YouTube showing you how to work the problems. 3) I reviewed several years of past exams and placed enfaces on the easiest and most common questions. Mastering these questions should yield a 75% to 80%. If a student is already achieving this percentage; the other guides or web site with random questions and covering all material might be best. A book might be better for your student than the web sites for two reasons. 1) The more common and easiest questions are using a ruler to measure. The web designers don't know the size of your computer screen and can't determine if the student has measured correctly. We can get a high percentage of these problems easily. 2) When studying on a computer there are too many websites with the answers.
